You may already know, but we wanted to send out a reminder that Mason County Eastern Schools has been approved to offer » **FREE MEALS TO ALL KIDS (AGE 18 & YOUNGER)**

**Who can get free meals?**

Any student, whether they are doing in-person learning at school or virtual/remote learning at home, can get free meals. Free meals are also available to children 18 years & younger who are not enrolled in MCE. This includes younger children who are not in school yet, children enrolled in other districts and children who are homeschooled.

**Where are the free meals available?**

Meals are available for pick up at Mason County Eastern Schools Cafeteria on Tuesday between 1:30 and 2:30 p.m. Children do not have to be present for meal pick-up.

**What is being served?**

Children will receive 5 breakfasts, 5 lunches, and 5 snacks. Menus are posted on our website at [mceschools.com](http://mceschools.com).

**Why have things kept changing?**

Our program has to follow certain rules set at the national level by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA). We have made changes based on what is allowed by the USDA.
